

# ANALYSIS OF THE SURVEY OF HIGHER EDUCATION STUDENTS OF "PSYCHOLOGY"

Number of respondents: 82 people

Main questions of the questionnaire and generalized answers:

1. Are you satisfied with the quality of teaching of disciplines?

- Yes – 89%
- Partially – 21%
- No – 3%

2. Does the training meet your expectations for the chosen specialty?

- Yes – 83%
- Partially – 27%
- No – 4%

3. How do you assess the sufficiency of hours for lectures / practical classes?

- Enough – 89%
- I would like more practice – 11%
- Not enough – 3%

4. Is the assessment system clear and objective?

- Yes – 84%
- Not always – 15%
- No – 5%

5. Do you feel respected and supported by your teachers?

- Always – 83%
- Sometimes – 7%
- No – 4%

6. Is the educational environment comfortable and safe?

- Yes – 83%
- There are difficulties in places – 17%
- No – 4%

7. Do you participate in scientific, creative, volunteer activities?

- Yes – 47%

- Sometimes – 35%

- No – 12%

8. Do you want to do an internship or training in your specialty? ● Yes – 95%

- Not sure – 7%

- No – 2%

9. Would you like to have more interaction with practicing psychologists?

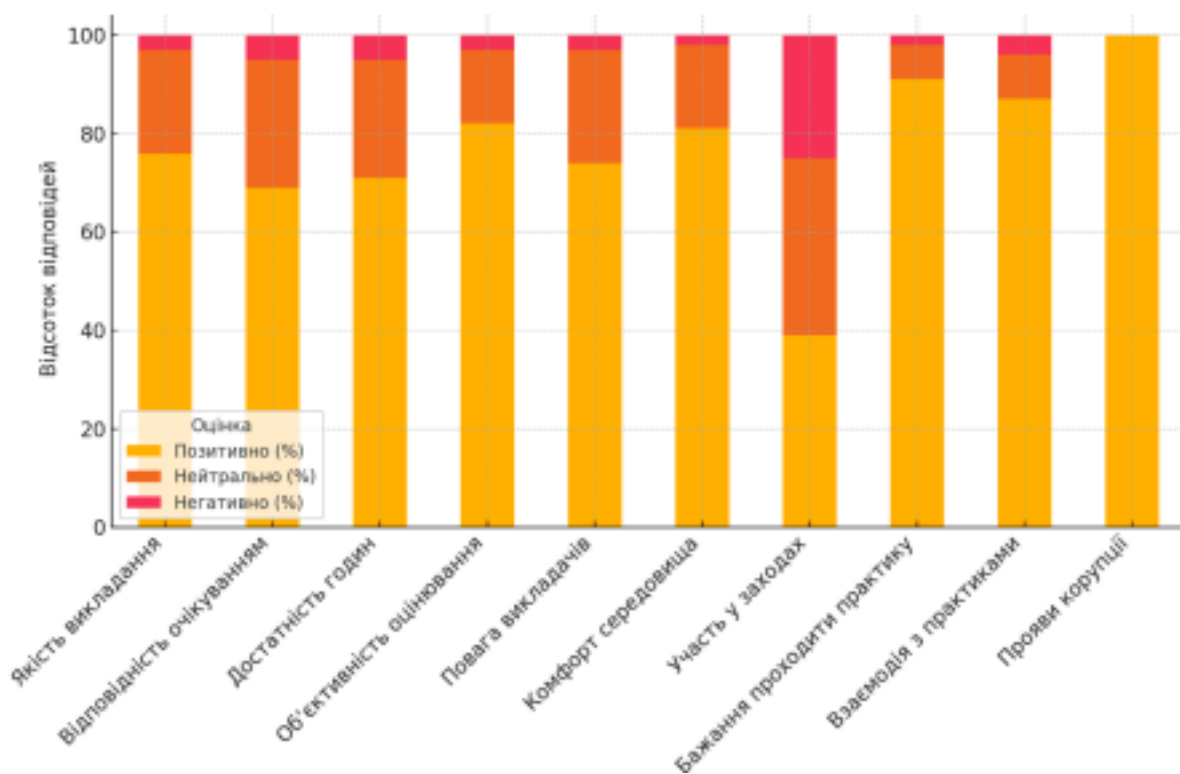
- Yes – 81%

- It is not important – 9%

- No – 5%

10. Is there corruption in the educational process?

- No – 100%



General conclusions from the survey:

- The teaching staff received high marks: 89% of respondents are satisfied with the quality of teaching, 84% consider the evaluation system objective, and 83% noted support from teachers.

- The educational process leaves a positive impression on most students – over 83% believe that the learning meets their expectations.

- Practical training remains important: 95% of students seek internships, and 91% want more contact with practicing psychologists.
- There are no corruption cases – 100% of students did not record a single case.
