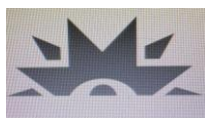

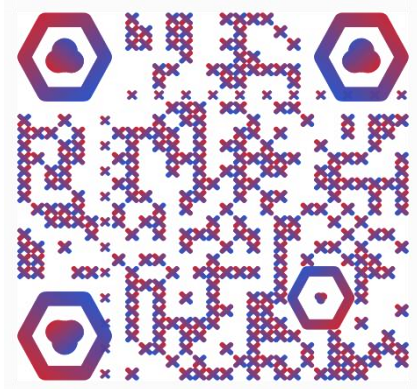

**SUPERVISION AS A COMPONENT OF THE PROFESSIONAL  
DEVELOPMENT OF A PSYCHOLOGIST**

The concept of supervision has existed almost as long as the profession of psychology itself. The development of supervision within psychotherapy can be broadly aligned with the evolution of psychotherapeutic theory and practice. Its roots lie in the apprenticeship model, in which a “master” transmitted knowledge and skills to an “apprentice.” As therapists began training other therapists, systems of supervision emerged within the traditions of various approaches.
